The Ophthalmic Nursing diploma course will enable students to gain skills and knowledge that will find them jobs attending to the eye care of patients in the ward, operation theatre and ICU. The bare minimum qualification is a pass in Plus Two (Central of State board), with high marks in Biology/Mathematics, Physics, and Chemistry. Students who are between 17 - 20 years as on May 1, 2011 can apply.

The same category of students can even apply for the three-year B.Sc. degree course in Ophthalmic Nursing and Medical Lab Technology.
